This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in Mathematics from 50% in Year 2 (2017) to 60% in Year 3 (2018).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in Mathematics from 47% in Year 3 (2017) to 60% in Year 5 (2018).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English from 12% in Year 5 (2017) to 30% in Year 6 (2018).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English from 39% in Year 3 (2017) to 50% in Year 4 (2018).
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) for numeracy from 27% in Year 3 (2016) to 35% in Year 5 (2018).
- Increase the percentage of students in the U2B for reading from 32% in Year 3 (2016) to 45% in Year 5 (2018).

Our initiatives include

- Use Early Start materials and Literacy continuum across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress.
- Undertake data captures and reviews using the updated Moura State School Data Collection Requirements for numeracy, reading and writing, and develop individual student learning targets.
- Provide professional development and coaching to develop teachers' ability to align curriculum, teaching and assessing of the Australian Curriculum: Mathematics.
- Provide professional development and coaching to develop teachers' ability to align curriculum, teaching and assessing of the Australian Curriculum: English.
- Mentor and coach teachers and teacher-aides to implement reading, writing intervention and to analyse data effectively.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchase of human resources to support in class English and Maths teaching including teacher-aide assistance and professional release time for teachers. \$86,911
- Professional development/coaching activities in Maths, Reading and Australian Curriculum. \$ 5,000
- Purchase of physical resources. \$ 1,000
