This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students in the U2B for writing from 62% to 70% in 2014.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students in the U2B for reading from 38% to 45% in 2014.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 students reaching NAPLAN U2B from 26% to 35% in 2014.
- Increase the percentage of Year 7 students in U2B for reading to 25% in 2014.
- Increase the percentage of Year 7 students above NMS for reading to 85%.
- Develop a learning plan for students who are below National Minimum Standards.
- Ensure teachers reach mastery of Explicit Instruction by the end of 2014.

Our strategy will be to

- Implement Write2Spell in all year levels. (Sam Woods B. Occ. Th.)
- Implement a Reading Intervention Program based on SCORE strategy and M100 sight words for Prep-Yr 7 students. (Project 600)
- Undertake 5 weekly data captures and reviews using the Moura SS Data Collection Requirements and develop individual student learning targets. (Masters, Hattie)
- Implement a Writing intervention plan that involves a weekly focused Writing Hour, ideas from the 7 Steps to Writing program, analysis of 5 weekly writing samples. (Jan McVeity)
- Monitor and support teachers and teacher-aides to implement reading, writing and to analyse data effectively.

• Purchase of human resources to support in class English and Maths teaching, including teacher-aide assistance and professional release time for teachers.	\$ 76 966
• Professional development activities in reading, writing and explicit instruction.	\$ 6000
